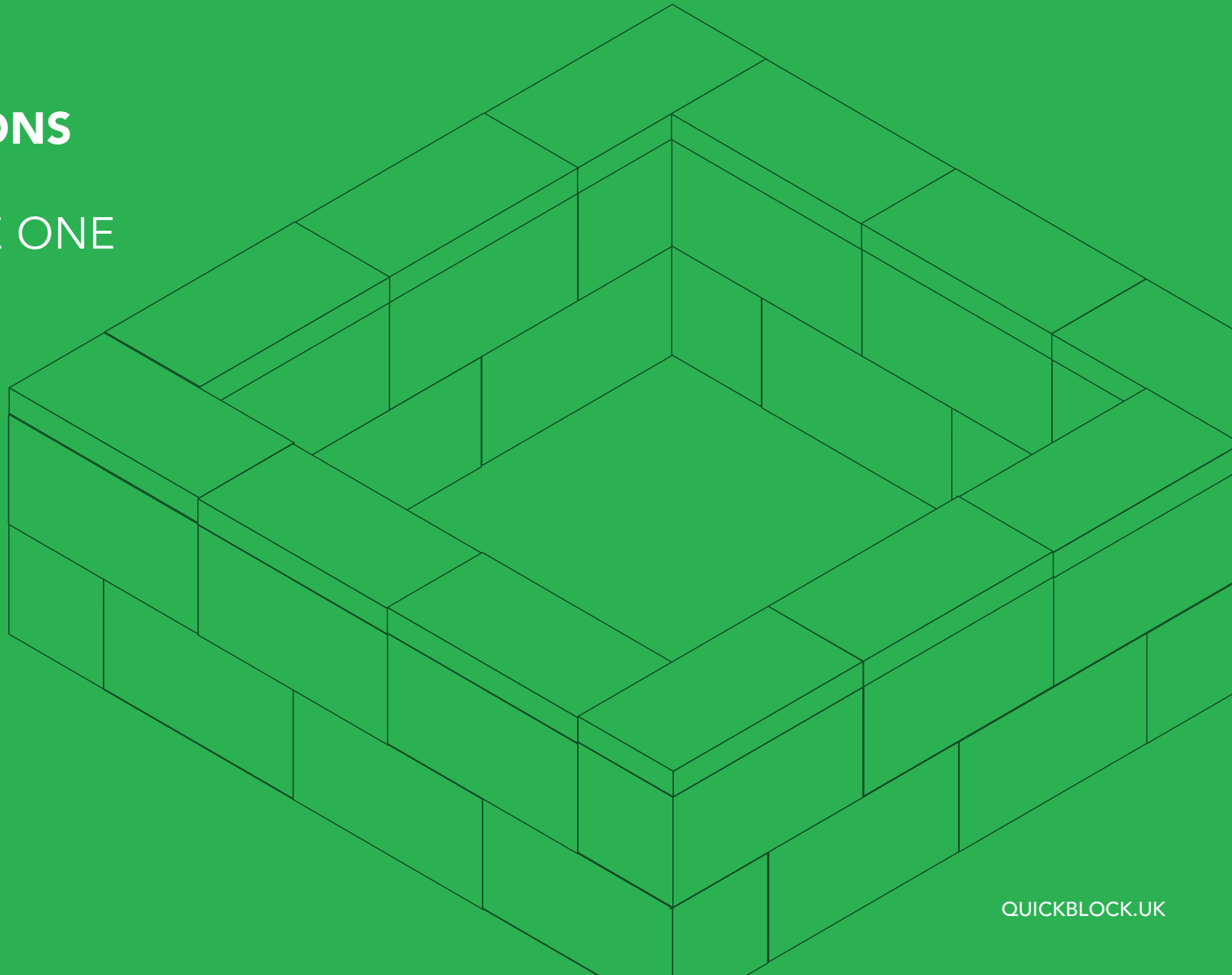

## PLANTER

### THE MIDDLE ONE

Building your QUICKBLOCK planter is as easy as open, click, build. Within minutes you will have a planter to grow anything you like.

This is our middle sized planter and once built is 1,368mm wide, 1,368mm long, and 478mm high.

Included in the kit:

- 20 Full Blocks
- 10 Capping Pieces
- 80 Pins



You can plant anything you normally would in any planter.





## STEP 1



To lay the bottom layer, place two blocks side by side with their short sides touching at the left end of the footprint. Next, position three of blocks in the middle with their short sides touching, but place these three outside the structure line so it continues the square around the perimeter. Do the same on the other side. Ensure all blocks are aligned, evenly spaced, and pushed tightly together to form a straight and secure base.

## STEP 2



For the next layer, place the QUICKBLOCKs on top of the base in a brickwork pattern, ensuring that each block overlaps the joints of the layer below. Position the blocks so that the overhang is equal on both sides, keeping the structure balanced and aligned as you build upward.

## STEP 3



To complete the build, place the capping pieces on top of the structure in a brickwork pattern to ensure stability, and use the provided pins to secure them in place, which will also create a cleaner, more polished finish by filling the exposed holes.

## ENJOY



Now for the best part, get creative! Fill your planter with soil and grow whatever makes you happy, from bright flowers to tasty herbs. For extra stability, you can add sand into the sides (under the capping pieces), or if you'd like even more planting space, simply remove the caps and fill the sides with soil too.

The capping piece edge also doubles as a handy seat, giving you extra comfort and support while filling, planting, or weeding, a simple feature that makes gardening even easier.
