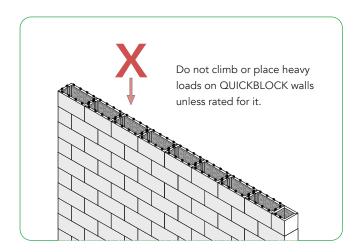
Follow the QUICKBLOCK instructions when building ensuring all blocks are locked firmly in place.

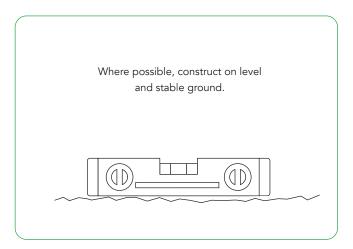














Avoid using blocks in ways not intended by the manufacturer. For more info, see the instruction manual.








Opening blocks with excess force may result in blocks becoming damaged. It is recommended that blocks are opened with two hands and moderate force. QUICKBLOCK does not accept responsibility for blocks that are broken due to user error.

CAPPING PIECES

Adding a clean, flush finish to the top of a QUICKBLOCK structure goes hand-in-hand with increased strength and rigidity, through the integration of Capping Pieces.

Capping pieces are sold in Full-Block lengths only, but can be easily 'snapped' to create two Half-Block length Capping Pieces, as explained in these instructions.





INSTRUCTIONS BUILD WITH CAPPING PIECES QUICKBLOCK.UK

STEP 1



As with the rest of your QUICKBLOCK structure, placement of **Capping Pieces** follows the basic bricklaying pattern*. Full-Block length capping pieces should overlap two adjacent blocks evenly.

STEP 2



Where necessary, Half-Block length **Capping Pieces** may be needed.

The **Capping Piece** is designed to 'snap' easily at its midpoint. Grab the ends, and bring the centre down on your knee in a swift motion.

If not fully separated at this point, flip the **Capping Piece** over and repeat.

STEP 3



Place Half-Block length **Capping Pieces** at the ends of walls to create a clean, flush finish.
